South Central Regional Transit District Bus Schedules Now on Google Maps
Three-County Service Provides Over 30,000 Trips annually

The South Central Regional Transit District (SCRTD) bus route schedules are now accessible via Google maps. Anyone traveling within Doña Ana County on any of the district's four bus routes: Red, Blue, Turquoise and Purple, can locate their trip times via Google Maps 24 hours a day, seven days a week. However, for now, bus service is only available Monday through Friday.

The Transit District carried over 30,333 trips last year and continues to add riders. Chairman of the SCRTD Board of Directors, Javier Perea said, "This new added service, in addition to Wi-Fi on our buses, will enhance our service."

The South Central Regional Transit District was formed in 2006 due to passage of the Regional Transit District Act of 2003. The agency's services are funded from a membership fees, an annual membership agreement for service with Doña Ana County, and grants from the State of New Mexico, the United States Department of Transportation Federal Transit Administration, and rider fares. The members of the SCRTD are Doña Ana County and the municipalities of Las Cruces, Hatch, Mesilla, Sunland Park, Elephant Butte, Truth or Consequences, Williamsburg, and Anthony.
