A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT STAFF TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE FY2022 SECTION 5339(b) GRANT PROGRAM FOR THREE ELECTIC BUSES TO REPLACE EXISTING FLEET VEHICLES AND FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the USDOT issued a notice for funding opportunity for the FFY2022 Section 5339(b) Grant for Buses and Bus Facilities Program on December 1, 2021: and


WHEREAS, the SCRTD staff has submitted its application to NMDOT (to be included in the State's consolidated application); and

WHEREAS, the SCRTD has identified capital improvements related to the efficient and effective day-to-day operations and maintenance of fleet; and

WHEREAS, upon selection to receive FY2022 Section 5339(b) Bus and Bus Facilities Infrastructure Investment Program funds, the SCRTD is committed to provide a twenty (20) percent match (\$748,071) of the project cost (\$3,740,354).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the SCRTD Board that, the request for SCRTD Board authorization and support of Staff submitting for a FY2022 Section 5339(b) Grant for Buses and Bus Facilities Program in the amount of \$3,740,354 with a SCRTD match of \$748,071 to fund the purchase of three electric buses to replace existing fleet vehicles.
