**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A SUBMISSION FOR A GRANT AMENDMENT OF THE SCRTD ELECTRIC BUS ACQUISITION PHASE III GRANT TO THE EL PASO MPO**

**WHEREAS**, the South Central Regional Transit District Board of Directors met in a meeting Wednesday, March 26, 2025, in the Doña Ana County Offices, 845 N. Motel Blvd., Las Cruces N.M.; and,

**WHEREAS**, the South Central Regional Transit District (SCRTD) has received approval to amend the SCRTD Electric Bus Acquisition Phase III grant to the El Paso Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO); and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of this amendment is to secure funding to support the addition of a hybrid electric bus to the SCRTD fleet, enhancing the district's commitment to sustainable transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, his addition will further the SCRTD's efforts to expand its zero-emission vehicle initiative, improve environmental sustainability, and increase service capacity; and

**WHEREAS**, the hybrid electric bus will reduce operational costs through energy-efficient transportation options and align with the District's goals of promoting cleaner, more environmentally friendly public transit services; and

**WHEREAS**, this amendment to the SCRTD Electric Bus Acquisition Phase III grant will provide the necessary funding to continue expanding the SCRTD fleet with environmentally friendly, energy-efficient vehicles.
