

Formation & Mission


Formed in November 2023 under NM Transit District legislation




Mission: Provide safe, reliable regional transit support rural, intercity, and workforce mobility, strengthen economic connectivity across Doña Ana County

SCRTD 10-Year Service Timeline (2016–2026)






