**A RESOLUTION
APPROVING THE SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT SUBMITTAL OF FY2028
SECTION 5310 AND SECTION 5311 ANNUAL GRANT APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) provides funding through the Section 5310 Program, *Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities*, and the Section 5311 Program, *Formula Grants for Rural Areas*, to assist eligible public transportation providers in meeting the mobility needs of the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS, the South Central Regional Transit District desires to submit annual grant applications for Fiscal Year 2028 funding under the FTA Section 5310 and Section 5311 programs through the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) Transit and Rail Division; and

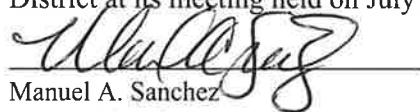
WHEREAS, funding received through these grant programs will assist the District in providing safe, reliable, and accessible public transportation services, including operating assistance, preventive maintenance, capital improvements, mobility services for seniors and individuals with disabilities, and other eligible transit activities; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors recognizes that participation in these federal grant programs supports the District's mission of improving mobility, enhancing regional connectivity, and maintaining compliance with all applicable federal and state regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SOUTH CENTRAL REGIONAL TRANSIT DISTRICT THAT:

1. The South Central Regional Transit District hereby approves the submission of the Fiscal Year 2028 Federal Transit Administration Section 5310 and Section 5311 Annual Grant Applications through the New Mexico Department of Transportation Transit and Rail Division.
2. The Executive Director is hereby authorized to prepare, execute, and submit all grant applications, certifications, assurances, agreements, and supporting documentation necessary to obtain FY2028 Section 5310 and Section 5311 funding.
3. The Executive Director is further authorized to execute all grant agreements, amendments, reimbursement requests, and related documents necessary to administer the awarded grants in accordance with applicable federal and state laws, regulations, and grant requirements.
4. The South Central Regional Transit District agrees to provide any required local matching funds and to comply with all applicable Federal Transit Administration and New Mexico Department of Transportation requirements associated with these grant programs.
