SCRTD Recent Updates

Secured \$5.04 Million in Federal Funding

SCRTD received \$5.04 million through the Federal Transit Administration's Low or No Emission Vehicle Program. This major investment supports the purchase of additional electric buses, expands charging infrastructure, reduces emissions, and strengthens long-term system reliability for riders across the region.

New Magenta Route Launching December 15

SCRTD is launching the new Magenta Route connecting the Las Cruces Mesilla Valley Intermodal Transit Terminal (MVITT) to the Butterfield Community Center. This route will provide improved access to work, schools, and essential services for residents in the Butterfield and East Mesa areas.

Yellow Route Service Improvements

Service changes to the Yellow Route now provide 40-minute frequency between Sunland Park, NM, and Downtown El Paso, TX. These improvements reduce wait times and offer riders faster, more reliable access to employment, education, medical services, and shopping destinations.

Solar Array Project

SCRTD is advancing its new solar array project to support clean energy operations at the district's facilities. Once completed, the solar installation will help lower energy costs, improve sustainability, and provide

renewable power to support electric bus charging and future fleet expansion.

Upcoming Purple Route Adjustments

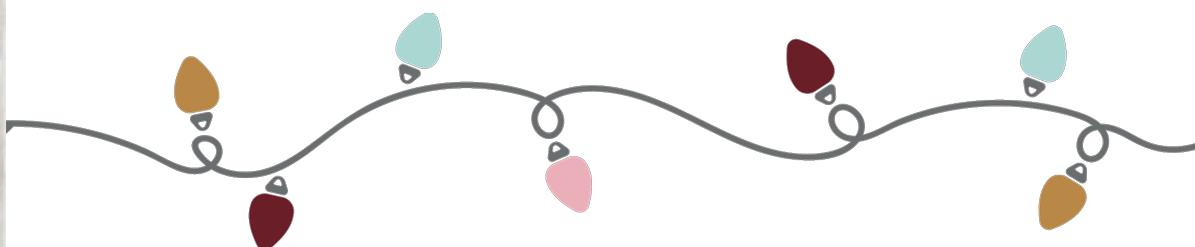
SCRTD is reviewing service changes to improve the Purple Route, with schedule updates planned for early 2026. As part of this process, SCRTD and El Paso County are evaluating opportunities to strengthen connectivity with Route 10 at the Anthony transfer point.
